William has also litigated cases in trial courts involving the pharmaceutical and financial-services industries. Before joining Paul, Weiss, William worked at Williams & Connolly LLP in Washington, DC, and clerked for the Honorable Jeffrey S. Sutton, United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit.
