Dr. Feng, a molecular biologist, has been interested in dissecting molecular signaling events and cross-talks of signaling pathways in health and diseases for three decades. The current focus of his research is on elucidating the anti-oncogenic effects of classical oncoproteins in hepatocarcinogenesis. Better understanding of the previously unrecognized complexity in liver tumorigenesis will likely lead to the design of effective therapeutic strategies for liver cancer.
