The Lysophospholipid and Related Mediators Conference: From Bench to Clinic

Eric Camerer leads a team at the Paris Cardiovascular Research Center that explores how proteases and lipids regulate vascular development and function through G protein-coupled receptor signaling. The group focuses on when and how sphingosine 1-phosphate signaling is engaged to regulate vascular function, and whether sphingosine 1-phosphate receptors provide useful therapeutic targets for microvascular dysfunction.

Camerer received his BSc in chemistry and biochemistry from Imperial College, London, his PhD with Dr. Hans Prydz at the University of Oslo, and his postdoctoral training with Dr. Shaun Coughlin at the University of California, San Francisco.
