Dr. Felix is associate professor at Erasmus MC, University Medical Center Rotterdam, the Netherlands. She has a background in medicine and (genetic) epidemiology. Within the population-based Generation R Study, a birth cohort of almost 10,000 children and their parents, Dr.Felix's research focuses on understanding genetic and epigenetic processes underlying cardiometabolic phenotypes in pregnant women and children. She has extensive experience in genome- and epigenome-wide association studies in large international consortia, mainly the EGG (Early Growth Genetics) and PACE (Pregnancy And Childhood Epigenetics) Consortia, each with over 30,000 participants. She also leads the NutriPROGRAM Consortium, an international consortium focusing on early-life nutrition and DNA-methylation.
