### **Eligibility:**

Outstanding students and postdocs who have excelled in their research as trainees.

### **How to Apply:**

The student or postdoc should have completed and paid for registration as well as completed an abstract submission at [www.westphotosynthesis.org](http://www.westphotosynthesis.org). In addition, applicants should submit by email the following documents contained in a single PDF to [WPC2017@utk.edu](mailto:WPC2017@utk.edu):

- Current CV with publications (limit to two pages)
- Duplicate Abstract submitted to the WPC/2017 meeting
- Signed advisor letter of recommendation with contact information (one page)

### **Deadline:**

All documents must be received by Midnight Friday November 4th, 2016 in order for an application to be considered.

### **Notification:**

Awardees will be selected by the week of November 7th and all applicants will receive an update regarding the status of their application by November 14, 2016.
